





## Why do we need HDR UK?

# Prescribing Costs in Hospitals and the Community - England 2021/22

Published 10 November 2022

- In 2022/23 in England, 1.18 billion items were dispensed in the community, costing £10.4B
- In hospitals, in 2021/22, costs of prescribing were £8.77 billion, 49.3% of total expenditure on drugs that year.

# PREVALENCE AND ECONOMIC BURDEN OF MEDICATION ERRORS IN THE NHS IN ENGLAND

- 237 million medication errors
- 3.8 million bed days
- 22,303 deaths per annum
- £1.6 billion annual cost

## Good for you, good for us, good for everybody


A plan to reduce overprescribing to make patient care better and safer, support the NHS, and reduce carbon emissions

- 15% of patients on 5 or more medicines
- Elderly, those with disabilities and minority ethnic backgrounds disproportionately affected
- 10% of prescriptions should not have been issued (110 million)
