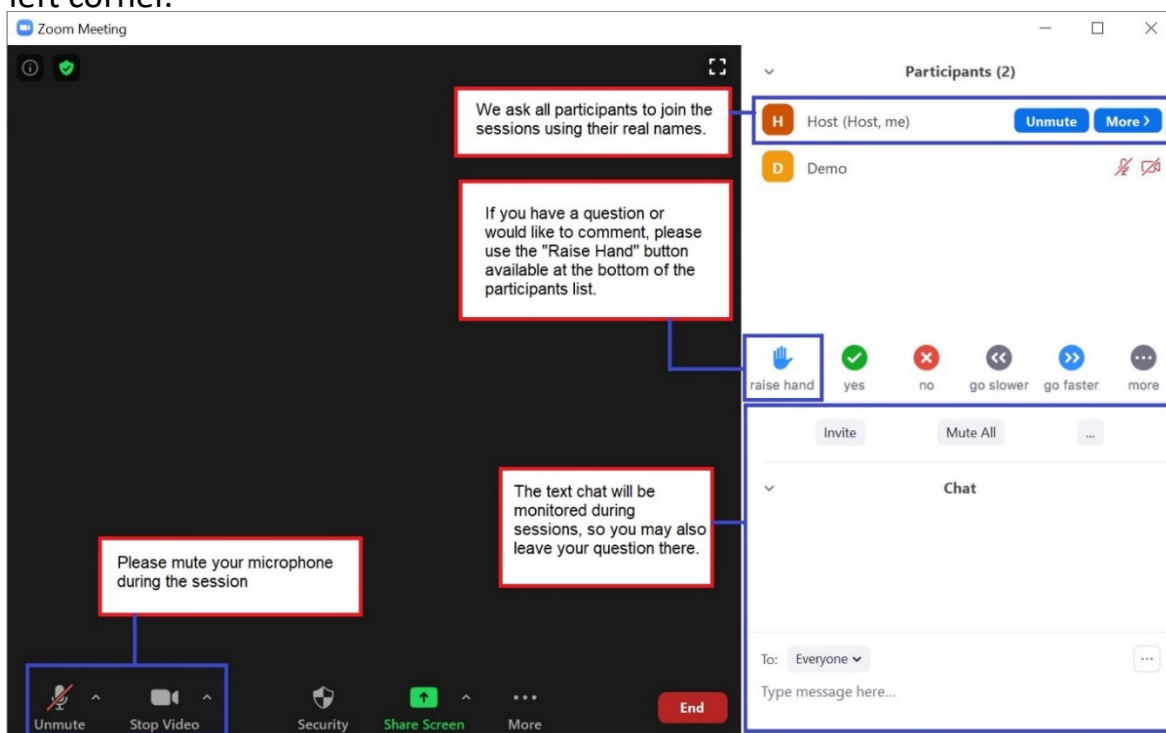
## Zoom Guide
